TEACHING EXPERIENCE

I have taught Rural Population Trends, Urbanism and Urbanization, Applied Demography, various seminars on population topics, Introductory Rural Sociology, Introductory Social Statistics, Intermediate Social Statistics, Multivariate Analysis in Sociological Research, and Introduction to Research Methods.

RESEARCH

Most of my research concerns population distribution and change in nonmetropolitan areas of the United States. This has included an examination of long-run trends in urbanization and redistribution; factors associated with the growth and decline of cities, villages, and rural areas; migration, particularly between metropolitan and nonmetropolitan areas, and the residential preferences of the population. Also I have considered rural-urban relationships, particularly in the study of part-time farming and commuting, as well as the residential preferences of the US population. Current work concerns nonmetropolitan population change and migration in recent decades, giving special attention to the black population in the South, and to the elderly population. With Leann Tigges I have studied nonmetropolitan commuting patterns.
