The Teaching Assistantship position will be 50%-time for the period of August 17, 2026, through December 30, 2026. The stipend for a 50%-time semester assistantship will be \$15,385. This position includes eligibility for health insurance, tuition remission, and other benefits.

Duties include working closely with Prof. Michael Bell attending lectures (M/W 2:30-3:45), leading four discussion sections (25 students per section), and grading papers and exams. Discussion sections are scheduled for Thursday 9:55-10:45, 11:00-11:50, and 3:30-4:20 and Friday 12:05-12:55 and 1:20-2:10.
