This Fall 2026 lectureship will be 50%-time for the period of August 17, 2026 through December 30, 2026. The stipend for a 50%-time semester graduate assistant lectureship will be \$16,873. This position includes eligibility for health insurance, tuition remission, and other benefits.

Duties include teaching Community and Environmental Sociology course 222, a 3-credit course scheduled on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 12:05 - 12:55 PM. Responsibilities include planning, organizing and delivering all instructional activities for an elementary level course in the field of Community and Environmental Sociology.

Applicants should provide a draft syllabus, but not necessarily a weekly schedule of specific readings. We are more interested at this time in your proposed overall organization and themes for the course. Applicants should also provide the name and contact information for one reference, prior teaching evaluations (if available), and a brief statement of familiarity with the subject matter of the course and with community and environmental sociology.

Note that the Department's policy is to give students in the Sociology and Community and Environmental Sociology joint graduate program first priority in hiring.
